Presentation

This year's Symposium will be face-to-face and will be held in Barcelona on **Friday**, **June 2 and Saturday**, **June 3**, **2023**. This year we want to do an intensive course on HIV and CNS that will take up most of the first day. Our intention is to teach the new generation of health professionals who have had limited and fragmented knowledge on the subject, also, update the older ones despite their experience.

More than ever, we hope this edition will be an educational tool that helps doctors who care for HIV-positive patients to diagnose and treat the psychiatric and psychological problems that patients may present.

The issue of the nervous system and mental health in people with HIV is of clear interest. Aspects such as stigma, isolation, psychiatric comorbidities, drug use, neurocognitive impairment, CNS as a special reservoir of HIV, pharmacokinetics of antiretroviral drugs in the CNS, drug interactions between psychotropic drugs and antiretroviral drugs, adverse effects of ART on the CNS, the fourth 90 including mental health, well-being and quality of life indicate the variety, complexity, breadth and timeliness of the content of the symposium. As an example, consider the number of CNS and topic-specific presentations at recent national and international HIV conferences

The Symposium will be addressed to infectious diseases and HIV doctors, internal medicine doctors, psychiatrists, psychologists, neurologists, community persons, and any other persons interested in the topic..

Rationale and goals

Rationale

Good mental health is related to mental and psychological well-being. The promotion of mental well-being, the prevention of mental disorders, the protection of human rights and the care of those who present mental disorders are necessary. People at risk of becoming infected with HIV or with HIV infection face multiple threats to the integrity and maintenance of their mental health.

People at risk of becoming infected with HIV tend to have not only more difficulties in accessing health consultancy, but more neuropsychological pathologies and have higher consumption of psychotropic substances. Recent coverage of pre-exposure prophylaxis has provided a global comprehensive framework of care which includes mental health care.

Despite the improved prognosis of HIV infection thanks to the antiretroviral therapy, the mental health of HIV-positive patients is still subject of great clinical, social and research importance. Besides the traditional stigma problems and neuropsychiatric disorders most frequently presented by patients, other circumstances are added such as the impact of aging, social isolation, the neurotoxicity of antiretrovirals and the greater consumption of substances with psychotropic effects, the epidemic, the new coronavirus, has had and has a negative effect on many of these aspects and has blocked the patients' access to the healthcare system. The consequences will be long-lasting and they require a multidisciplinary and extensive approach.

On the other hand, the central nervous system is an anatomical compartment of difficult access where HIV can constitute a reservoir which also means a challenge in the current antiretroviral treatment strategy and in other future eradication strategies. Its researching requires sophisticated imaging techniques and specific laboratory markers.

The great variability of topics related to HIV and the central nervous system, its changing aspect and the reliable absence of updated training on the subject, as well as the profound and extensive impact on the quality of life of people at risk of HIV and people with HIV are the main reasons to keep working and promoting this Symposium.

As the main objective of the Symposium, it should be noted that attendees will learn to diagnose and treat the psychiatric and neuropsychological aspects of people at risk of and with HIV infection in the post-coronavirus era
